Notes:

- (1) This is in addition to the membership fee for LLWSC and is a single payment of £20 per boat.
- (2) This fee is for families - 1 or 2 cohabiting adults with or without children under 18.
- (3) For students 18 – 23 in full-time education. The end date of the course needs to be included.

Lake Rules – Power Boat Drivers (Ski/Wakeboard Boats)

From 2024 **ALL BOAT DRIVERS** will need to hold one of the following qualifications:

- BWSW SBD (course available through Llangorse Lake Water Ski Club) or
- RYA's Powerboat Level 2 qualification.

Lakeside Reception will need to see proof of qualification/s when registering, along with your BWSW membership and insurance before you can use the lake.

The only exception being, if a qualified driver is acting as an instructor for someone who is learning to drive/pass the above qualifications. **NOTE:** When providing instruction to a driver without a qualification, the person providing instruction **MUST** be positioned near to the driver.

Any boat drivers who do not hold the required qualification at the start of the 2024 will be added to a list requiring qualification – if they do not gain the qualification within that season, they will not be allowed to drive any power boat on the Lake.
